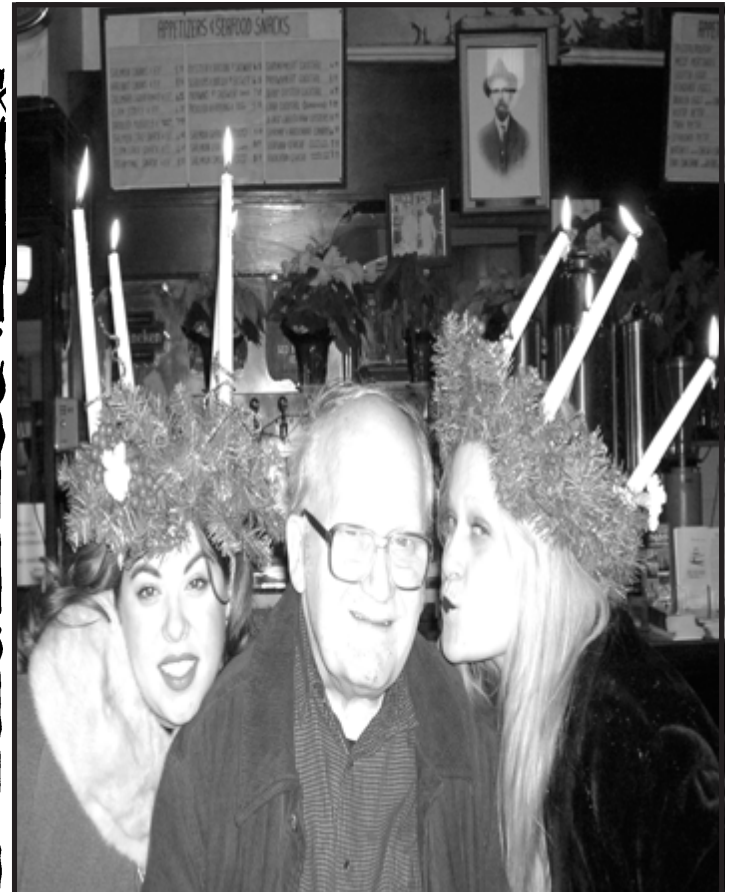

found elsewhere in the City.” To create a balance and the Historical Commission established various zones in the district to identify areas where a concentration of highest priority uses is essential for preservation.

As it was historically, the down under areas are in zone 3 which is permitted for all uses, including food and housing, social services, and retail. Downstairs you will still find two floors for merchant businesses including a coin shop, a business selling old prints and maps, a health food store, a magic shop, stores of used books, CD's and videos, vintage comics, clothes, ceramics, antiques, and merchants of treasures from around the world. If you listen carefully, the old halls still echo with laughter from Vi's lunch counter, and ghosts of those long gone continue to filter through the twilight hours into night; but that's another story.

Take a trip downstairs, we'll leave the light on for you.

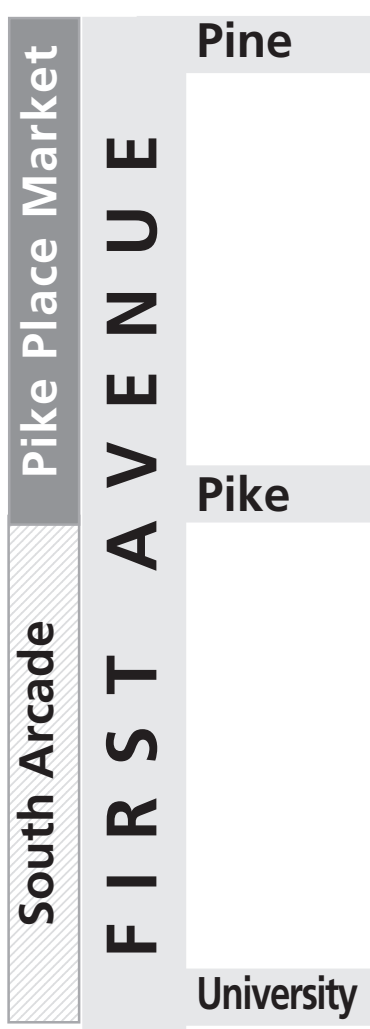
